

Evaluation:

The Institute evaluates the overall performance of trainees on the based on various activities, including a written examination, mock trial, an oral presentation on a legal problem, statute review, attachment program, study tour, discipline, attendance and punctuality. The examination paper is evaluated both by internal and external examiners. Evaluation processes are carried out in accordance with the **Training Evaluation Guidelines** of the Institute. After completion of a course, the Institute provides the trainee with their results (mark sheet and certificate) and communicates the results to supervising authorities, such as the Ministry of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs and the Supreme Court

The following grading system is maintained for the evaluation of trainees:

Serial No.	Number(%)	Standard and grade
1.	80 % and above	Outstanding (A +)
2.	70%-79%	Very Good(A)
3.	60%-69%	Good (A-)
4.	50%-59%	Average (B)
5.	Below 50%	Failed (F)

The trainees also evaluate their instructors by filling out evaluation forms. These evaluations are considered in the selection of the trainers for upcoming training programs.
